Recently, the spread of **COVID-19** and the annual flu season have brought more attention to the practice of infection prevention and control that dental facilities follow every day. All clinicians should follow **standard precautions** to protect themselves and their patients. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Summary of Infection Prevention Practices in Dental Settings: Basic Expectations for Safe Care¹ explains:

“Standard Precautions are the minimum infection prevention practices that apply to all patient care, regardless of suspected or confirmed infection status of the patient, in any setting where health care is delivered. These practices are designed to both protect DHCP and prevent DHCP from spreading infections among patients.”¹

Three standard precautions most relevant to the prevention of respiratory disease transmission:

- Hand hygiene
- Properly cleaning and disinfecting environmental surfaces
- Use of personal protective equipment (PPE)

When these surfaces are touched, microorganisms can be transferred to other surfaces, instruments or to the nose, mouth, or eyes of DHCP or patients.”

PPE that is appropriate for various types of patient interactions and effectively covers personal clothing and skin likely to be soiled with blood, saliva, or other potentially infectious materials (OPIM) should be available. These include gloves, face masks, protective eye wear, face shields, and protective clothing (e.g., reusable or disposable gown, jacket, laboratory coat).”
