# Clear Collection" Instrument Usage Guide Clockwise and Counter Clockwise Wedges 

The Clockwise and The Counter Clockwise Wedge instruments are used to produce indents into the facial and the lingual plastic for the rotational movement of a specific tooth. From an occlusal view, evaluate the tooth you wish to turn or rotate: Clockwise or Counter Clockwise (i.e. anti-clockwise). Select the appropriate wedge instrument to produce the desired rotation. Position it at the line angle near the embrasure, and indent the labial and the lingual to create a rotational couple for that tooth.
