Hu-Friedy pliers are crafted with Immunity Steel® alloy, a high quality surgical grade stainless steel which combines an optimal blend of carbon and chromium ensuring strength and corrosion resistance.



Debonding pliers are placed lingually such that one arm of the pliers reaches below the bracket.



The arm then hooks under the tie wing of the bracket while the other arm wedges under the bracket's adhesive interface. When squeezed, the wedged arm slides down the lingual surface of the tooth, successfully removing the bracket.
